Biography: I have been serving people and animals to realize their healing potential for over 25 years and teaching BCST since 2008. I'm committed to raising the health of this world exponentially. I began my self-discovery journey at the age of 28, with a severe health breakdown and diagnosis of Lupus, Chronic Fatigue Syndrome and Candida. I began seeking holistic therapies, incorporating a rigorous program of nutrition, supplements and homeopathics to support my body in my healing process. Through BCST, I started to explore and resolve the trauma that was a part of my dis-ease. My body has healed without the use of any pharmaceuticals or antibiotics since my diagnosis and is healthier than ever before.

Teaching Style: I have a neutral and grounded teaching style. I am present and authentic. I meet my students' learning needs through a variety of teaching methods. I create time to process individual experiences. Class time is coordinated and clearly structured with appropriate pacing which allows for flexibility to meet the group's needs.

Foundation Training Program: I teach a day program, with thirteen 4-day modules over a period of 36 months with three months in between each module.

Tuition: \$595 per module, \$7735 total. A \$250 deposit is required to register, with payment per module due 2 weeks prior to each module. Students pay whether they are present for every day of the module or not. Payment plans are available on an individual case by case basis.

Required activities/fees:

Students are required to receive 10 professional sessions from an RCST® outside of class for certification, cost determined by provider and is not included in tuition.

150 hours of practice sessions held outside of class.

What distinguishes your classes...I keep my class sizes small (max. of 10) so that I can give personal attention to everyone throughout the training. If I have an odd number of students, I like to bring in either current students further along in their training or graduates to even the table explorations. Their sharing is also very welcome, as it gives another perspective. I will also invite those students in for me to demo the explorations to model sessions and also assist the students in developing their intuitive skills.

I am approachable and welcome feedback, as my students are also my teachers. Also, my commitment to embodiment, which is the goal of genuine healing work, has been an informative, exciting, and sometimes painfully intense process. My experience gives me insight, compassion, and Mastery in teaching this work.
